

ORDINANCE NO. O-10-2017

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING AND FIXING THE AMOUNT OF SERVICE CHARGES FOR THE COLLECTION AND REMOVAL OF SOLID WASTE AND CURBSIDE RESIDENTIAL RECYCLING FOR THE CITY OF FORT THOMAS, CAMPBELL COUNTY, KENTUCKY FROM SEPTEMBER 1, 2017 THROUGH AUGUST 31, 2019.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FORT THOMAS, CAMPBELL COUNTY, KENTUCKY:

SECTION I

The following charges for the collection and removal of solid waste and curbside residential recycling shall be levied against property owners as hereby designated:

9/1/17 THROUGH 8/31/2019

8 Cubic Yard Container	\$ 2,429.00

SECTION II

If any part of this Ordinance is held invalid, such part shall be deemed severable and the invalidity thereof shall not affect the remaining parts of this Ordinance.

SECTION III

All ordinances, resolutions or part thereof, in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance, are to the extent of such conflict, hereby repealed.

SECTION IV

This Ordinance shall apply from September 1, 2017 through August 31, 2019 and shall become effective immediately and the requirements of a second reading of this Ordinance and publication are suspended due to an emergency. The waste fees must be approved before the city can mail its tax bills to its taxpayers. It is the city's wish to mail the tax bills approximately sixty (60) days prior to the due date of the taxes. Due to time constraints, meeting dates, and the availability of necessary information, the first reading of this Ordinance was not feasible until September 18, 2017. To require a second reading and publication would result in a delay of the mailing of the tax bills.
