## MUNICIPAL ORDER MO-01-2011

## A MUNICIPAL ORDER DECLARING THE CITY'S AMBULANCE AS SURPLUS PERSONAL PROPERTY AND AUTHORIZING THE SALE TO THE CITY OF NEWPORT.

**WHEREAS,** the Board of Council of the City of Fort Thomas, Campbell County, Kentucky, in accordance with the provisions of KRS 82.083, hereby makes the following findings and determinations:

- 1. It is in the public interest of the City to declare as surplus property, the 1999 Freightliner Ambulance 1FV3GLCC0XHA01779 Model FL60.
- 2. The intended use at the time of acquisition was for treatment and transportation of individuals to medical facilities by the City of Fort Thomas Fire Department.
- 3. It is in the public interest of the City to dispose of the ambulance due to excessive mileage, age, and maintenance costs.
- 4. The method of disposing of this personal property, ambulance, shall be the sale and transfer to the City of Newport for the sum of Twenty Thousand Dollars (\$20,000.00) pursuant to KRS 82.083(3)(a).

NOW THEREFORE, the ambulance shall be sold and transferred to the City of Newport for the sum of Twenty Thousand Dollars (\$20,000.00); and

The sale proceeds resulting from the disposal of the personal property described herein shall be transferred to the general fund of the city.
