

MUNICIPAL ORDER MO-04-2014

A MUNICIPAL ORDER DECLARING CITY-OWNED PERSONAL PROPERTY (GAS MONITORS) AS SURPLUS AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICER TO TRANSFER TO ANOTHER GOVERNMENTAL AGENCY.

SECTION I

Whereas, the Board of Council of the City of Fort Thomas, Campbell County, Kentucky, in accordance with the provisions of KRS 82.083 and KRS 45A.365, hereby makes the following findings:

1. The Board of Council has determined that it is in the public interest for the City to declare certain personal property, originally purchased as gas monitors for the fire department, as surplus due to age, obsolescence, and replacement; and
2. The Board of Council, upon recommendation of the city staff, has determined that the method of disposing of the surplus gas monitors shall be to transfer to another governmental agency, pursuant to KRS 82.083(3)(e) and KRS 45A.365 (3) and (4).

SECTION II

The Board of Council hereby declares the following as “surplus property” and hereby authorizes and directs the City Administrative Officer to proceed with their transfer to another governmental agency.

1. MSA Monoxor CO Detector (13 years old)
2. Bacharach CO Detector (13 years old)
3. GasAlertMicro Multi Gas Dector (10 years old)
4. Sensit TKX (10 years old)
