## *April 2020 Monthly Report Summary*

### **TRAINING:**

Officers completed the following rollcall training: Policy and Procedures quiz covering Chapters 8 and 9 in the Admin Manual and Chapter 4 in the Operations Manual.

All other training/school was cancelled due to COVID19.

### **ENFORCEMENT:**

In April officers wrote 6 speeding charges, 20 charges for non-traffic offenses (i.e., warrants, assaults, disorderly conduct, etc.) and 8 traffic related charges (i.e., suspended OL, no insurance, expired license plate, etc.) Officers also issued 8 written warnings. There were 21 drug related charges placed against 9 adults and 1 juvenile. Five of the individuals are Fort Thomas residents.

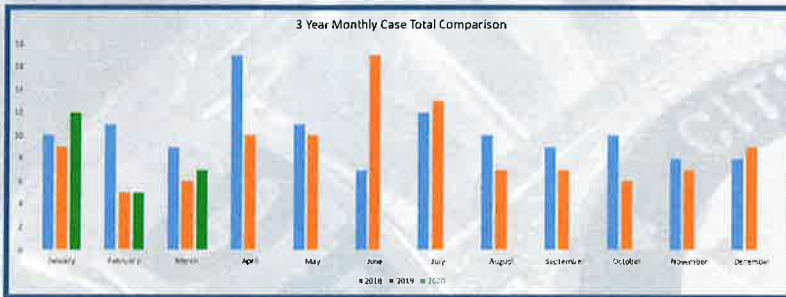

Detectives received 8 new cases in April. The majority are thefts, but additionally there was a theft of identity, a Wanton Endangerment, and a harassment report. A few of the reports involved multiple offenses which is why there are 10 charges listed in the table below.

### Trending

There appears to be an uptick in thefts and scams reported in April. Detectives worked with Richmond, KY PD to help stop a scam that was occurring in their city but stemmed from Fort Thomas. Over \$1,800 in computer equipment was seized as a result of the scam.

Detectives worked with several jurisdictions in an attempt to solve a felony smash and grab in St. Stephens cemetery. Below is a few pictures of evidence processing done on items that were recovered. The fingerprints that were located are currently at KSP lab for further analysis.



### REMEMBER...

While Fort Thomas hasn't been affected by COVID-19 scams yet, we want to remind everyone of these things to help protect yourself from those scams and identity theft.

- No government agency will ever ask you to send Google Play, Green-Dot gift cards or any other form of gift card type payment.
- Never send large amounts of cash.
- Monitor your credit through Experian, TransUnion, or Equifax.
- If you believe your identity has been stolen, notify credit bureaus and file a complaint through the Kentucky Attorney General's Office, and the Federal Trade Commission.
