July 2020 Monthly Report Summary

TRAINING:



Officer Brandon Laffin, Sergeant Derek Faught, and Lieutenant Chris Carpenter are regularly attending Police Defensive Tactics classes at Northern Kentucky Martial Arts Academy. The officers are learning techniques to safely and effectively bring combative subjects under control. As defensive tactics instructors, they pass on what they learn at NKY Martial Arts Academy to the other officers in the department through monthly training.

Sergeant Derek Faught attended *Working with the Media*. Key elements included: utilizing the media in emergency and public awareness situations; working with the media at the scene of an emergency; anticipating what news agencies want from first responders at the scene of an emergency; and giving interviews that work.

Sergeant Adam Noe attended **FEMA Training Intermediate ICS 300 for Expanding Incident (GMT-904)**. Topics included: ICS Staffing and organization; reporting and working relationships and information flow; transfer of command; unified command functions in a multi-jurisdictional or multiagency incident; ICS forms; resource management; interagency mission planning and procurement.

Sergeant Derek Faught attended **Critical Property Room Accountability and How To Achieve It**. Training included the common denominators of accountability, the value of having a robust and defensible policy and procedures, addressing issues of failure to train (landmark Supreme Court Case), and strategies for improvement. This webinar is critical for all levels, from the officer submitting evidence to the evidence and property room personnel and every level of supervision in between and the agency administration.

Roll Call Training: Officers completed training for the new **CIS MCS Mobile Client** that is replacing Interact MobileCop. One-hour tutorial by Sergeant Nathan Day.

ENFORCEMENT:

In July officers wrote 8 speeding charges, 27 charges for non-traffic offenses (i.e., warrants, assaults, disorderly conduct, etc.) and 56 traffic related charges (i.e., suspended OL, no insurance, expired license plate, etc.) Officers also issued 32 written warnings and totaled 20 court appearances. There were 24 drug related charges placed against 15 adults. Two of the individuals are Fort Thomas residents. Traffic stops led to 17 of the charges.
