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## *June 2020 Monthly Report Summary*

### **TRAINING:**

Detective Nick Hoffman completed online the following trainings provided by the National White Collar Crime Center: Mobile Digital Devices & GPS; Policies and Guidance for Intelligence Analysts Exercise; Basic Analyst Skills and Requirements; and Introduction to Intelligence.

Sergeant Derek Faught attended KY ID Law Enforcement Training Guide.

### **RECOGNITION:**

Officers Carl Harris and William Martin received a thank you note for assisting with a vehicle lockout. The owner states were two toddlers locked in the vehicle and the officers responded very quickly and were able to open the van. He added the officers were very friendly and professional and quickly resolved their emergency.

Detective Nick Hoffman received a thank you letter from a woman that reported her purse stolen. Detective Hoffman followed up on the case and called the victim to inquire about any activity on her missing credit cards. He was advised all the cards were cancelled and there were no charges made. The victim's purse was found approximately 8 weeks later and appeared that the contents were still in the purse. Officer Hoffman returned the property to the owner. She states that at a time in our nation when the foundation of peacekeeping agencies have been under attack and officers themselves assaulted, I must speak up on behalf of your department and Detective Hoffman, in particular. The FTPD took my loss seriously and Detective Hoffman delivered my purse promptly and courteously. Thank you so much for your service of personal safety to assure ours.

## **ENFORCEMENT:**

In June officers wrote 5 speeding charges, 13 charges for non-traffic offenses (i.e., warrants, assaults, disorderly conduct, etc.) and 20 traffic related charges (i.e., suspended OL, no insurance, expired license plate, etc.) Officers also issued 18 written warnings and totaled 20 court appearances. There were 17 drug related charges placed against 13 adults and 1 juvenile. Three of the individuals are Fort Thomas residents. Traffic stops led to 14 of the charges.

## **MICELLANEOUS:**

We would like to extend a sincere thank you to everyone who has called, stopped by our office, sent notes or just waved to the officers as they patrol the city to show their support to the department. Thank you for continuing to follow the policies established by the Governor.

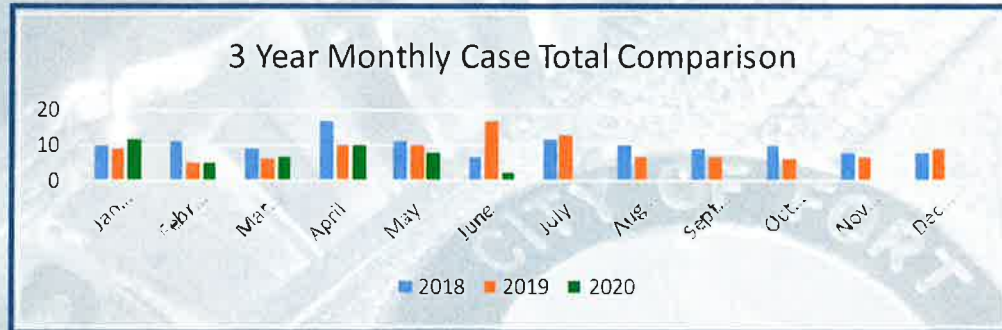
