May 2020 Monthly Report Summary

TRAINING:

Officers completed the following rollcall training: Policy and Procedures quiz covering Chapters 8 and 9 in the Admin Manual and Chapter 4 in the Operations Manual.

All other training/school was cancelled due to COVID19.

ENFORCEMENT:

In April officers wrote 4 speeding charges, 22 charges for non-traffic offenses (i.e., warrants, assaults, disorderly conduct, etc.) and 23 traffic related charges (i.e., suspended OL, no insurance, expired license plate, etc.) Officers also issued 25 written warnings. There were 18 drug related charges placed against 12 adults. Three of the individuals are Fort Thomas residents. Traffic stops led to 10 of the charges.

Detectives received 7 new cases in May. There were three thefts, two criminal mischief, one assault 1st Degree, and one suspicious death cases. Detectives received two less cases in 2020 compared to 2019, and three less cases compared to 2018.

REMEMBER...

While Fort Thomas hasn't been affected by COVID-19 scams yet, we want to remind everyone of these things to help protect yourself from those scams and identity theft.

No government agency will ever ask you to send Google Play, Green-Dot gift cards or any other form of gift card type payment.

Never send large amounts of cash.

Monitor your credit through Experian, TransUnion, or Equifax.

If you believe your identity has been stolen, notify credit bureaus and file a complaint through the Kentucky Attorney General's Office, and the Federal Trade Commission.
