December 2020 Monthly Report Summary

COMMUNITY EVENTS:

The Campbell County FOP #10 was able to serve over 90 children through the Cops and Kids event. FOP #10 represents every law enforcement agency in Campbell County with exception of Newport Police Department, which has its own union. This is the 26th year of providing Christmas to local children. Over 2,000 children have benefitted from FOP #10's efforts through the program's history. Local schools helped identify students who would most benefit from the program. This year, in order to follow social distancing guidelines, shopping took place at Meijer Cold Spring without the children, but kids met officers at the gift-wrapping and pick-up location.

TRAINING

Officers completed **Officer Involved Shooting** training with Officer Stacy Mays, Southgate Police Department. Officer Mays previously worked at Kentucky State Police investigating officer-involved shootings throughout the state of Kentucky.

ENFORCEMENT:

In December officers wrote 4 speeding charges, 14 charges for non-traffic offenses (i.e., warrants, assaults, disorderly conduct, etc.) and 14 traffic related charges (i.e., suspended OL, no insurance, expired license plate, etc.) Officers also issued 17 written warnings and totaled 10 court appearances. There were 14 drug related charges placed against 4 adults and 4 juveniles. Four of the individuals are Fort Thomas residents. Traffic stops led to 7 of the charges.

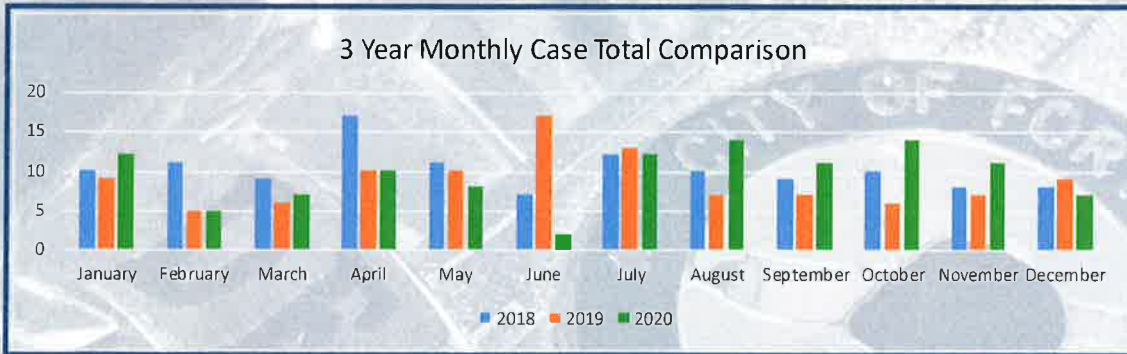
