February 2021 Monthly Report Summary

COMMUNITY EVENTS:

To celebrate Catholic School Week students at St. Thomas recognized community partners in celebration of their contributions to Fort Thomas. They once again recognized first responders for their service to the City. Students and teachers delivered hand-made thank you card and personally thanked each organization. Thank you to everyone involved.

TRAINING

Officer Kalin Holland attended ***Shadow Economy 101***. Communities are under siege by crimes for profit. When criminals make money (regardless of method: fraud, human trafficking, drugs, counterfeit or stolen goods, cargo, identity theft, or organized retail theft), they create a shadow economy. This illicit activity competes with and erodes the economic stability of our communities. Unique research into the economic impact of the shadow economy reveals the critical need to support skilled, targeted investigations and effective prosecution. Unfortunately, there are ever-increasing efforts to decriminalize non-violent crimes. These policies are fueling the unprecedented growth of the shadow economy. In order to defend communities from this threat, investigators will require a counter-narrative to illustrate how these policies are generating more crime, propagating violence, and ultimately leading to urban decay.

ENFORCEMENT:

In February officers wrote 12 speeding charges, 27 charges for non-traffic offenses (i.e., warrants, assaults, disorderly conduct, etc.) and 37 traffic related charges (i.e., suspended OL, no insurance, expired license plate, etc.) Officers also issued 43 written warnings and totaled 12 court appearances. There were 17 drug related charges placed against 11 adults. Traffic stops led to 16 of the charges.
